to believe that the Respondent, Richard Martin, ("Martin" or "Respondent"), violated the

West Virginia Governmental Ethics Act, in his public position as Mayor of Reedy, as

follows:

Count One On or about July 25, 2024 the Respondent violated W. Va. Code §

6B-2-5(b) and W. Va. Code R. § 158-6-5.2 (2022), by utilizing funds from the Reedy

maintenance account to pay his personal electric bill. The Respondent's act constituted

the use of public office for his own private gain..

Count Two In May and/or June of 2024, the Respondent violated W. Va. Code §

6B-2-5(b)(4) and W. Va. Code R. § 158-6-3 (2022) by favoring a relative, his father, by

rehiring him only one month after he had been given vacation and sick time that was

unearned as a retirement gift by city council. The Respondent's act constituted the use

of public office for the private gain of a relative.

Count Three In 2024, the Respondent took thousands of dollars in bingo/raffle cash proceeds that belonged to the city. The Respondent's act constituted the use of

public office for his own private gain.

In accordance with W. Va. Code § 6B-2-4(g), the Commission staff is hereby

Ordered to prepare a Statement of Charges and to schedule this matter for a public

hearing to determine the truth or falsity of the charges set forth in Counts One through

three.
