Dear Monica,

This agreement describes an engagement whereby Access Strategies, LLC will provide consulting/government relations services to Kanawha County Emergency Ambulance Authority (KCEAA). This engagement may be modified or extended by mutual agreement by both parties. The term is for one year (12 months).

The subject matter of this engagement is limited to matters relating to KCEAA and the business it conducts that may be considered by the West Virginia Legislature and/or the appropriate state regulatory bodies. This would include rules and legislation. We will rely on the KCEAA to provide subject matter guidance on these matters.

Amber Perry - of Access Strategies, LLC - will serve as the lead lobbyist on behalf of Access Strategies, LLC for the KCEAA, with the remaining members of Access Strategies, LLC being available for back-up.

The scope of Access Strategies, LLC's services is as follows:

- a. Register as a contract lobbyist for KCEAA and complete all legal and reporting requirements appurtenant to such registration,
- b. Monitor proposed legislation affecting KCEAA,
- c. Advocate the passage, or defeat, of proposals that would be a benefit, or be a detriment, to KCEAA's strategic goals, in consultation with their designee,
- d. Communicate with KCEAA via their designee on a regular basis, generally weekly during active legislative session(s), regarding legislative issues,
- e. Monitor executive and administrative activities on the state level

The hourly billing rate is \$150 per hour. Time will be tracked internally and billed once per month.

• Sales tax is 6% for the state and 1% city tax.

The above hourly rate does not include out of pocket expenses which will be billed separately. Such expenses will not exceed \$200 which also include the cost of the Ethics Registration Form. Any expenses above the \$200 will be approved in advance by the KCEAA in writing.

This contract does not include the provision of public relations or strategic planning. A separate engagement will be developed if those services are requested.
