A **State Licensing Board** asks: (1) Whether it may use public funds to hire its former Executive Director, a registered lobbyist, to serve as a Legislative liaison; (2) If it hires a registered lobbyist, whether the person must register on behalf of the Board; and, (3) Whether the newly enacted revolving door prohibitions relating to lobbying would prohibit the Board from hiring its former Executive Director to lobby on its behalf.
